

## THE STATE POOLED MONEY INVESTMENT BOARD HALTS THE FLOW OF STATE FUNDS TO INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

At its December 2008 through February 2009 board meetings, the Pooled Money Investment Board (the Board) suspended, with a few exceptions, the flow of state loan moneys to 5400 bond-funded capital projects. The Board took this action to ensure that the Pooled Money Investment Account (the Pool) continues to meet its primary responsibility to provide appropriate levels of liquidity to all Pool participants. The Board determined that restrictions on these loans (also known as AB 55 Loans) made for the projects are necessary because the state has been unable to convert the loans to longer-term debt. Due to the nationwide credit crunch, issuance of either commercial paper or bonds – the two essential methods of repaying AB 55 Loans – has been severely limited since June 2008.

The Board consists of the State Treasurer, Controller and Department of Finance. It meets monthly to take action that directs the investment of funds in the Pool. The Board's primary responsibilities in managing the Pool are preserving capital, maintaining prudent liquidity to Pool partici-

pants, and earning appropriately competitive returns for all commingled funds. Funds in the Pool are primarily from excess cash in state funds (special funds and the general fund), and deposits made by cities, counties and other local entities into the Local Agency Investment Fund. At the end of January 2009, the Pool's portfolio totaled \$61.5 billion, of which approximately 19 percent was dedicated to AB 55 Loans.

### AB 55 Loans

AB 55 Loans are lines of credit extended by the Board to state agencies or departments to provide interim funding, or construction loans, on authorized bond projects until commercial paper or bonds can be sold. The loan program was created in response to the Tax Reform Act of 1986. The lines of credit are considered an important service to the requesting agencies or departments.

Since the loan program started more than 20 years ago, the Pool has facilitated AB 55 Loans while maintaining sufficient liquidity for all participants. While adequate liquidity remained available

on demand, the Pool continued to maintain the AB 55 lines of credit. However, when the draws on these lines of credit encroached on a prudent level of liquidity for Pool participants, the Board had a legal duty to consider whether to continue funding AB 55 Loans. Monthly draws on AB 55 lines of credit averaged approximately \$660 million a month. Faced with a continued drain on the Pool resources and, considering the responsibility to provide necessary liquidity to all participants, the Board voted to limit further AB 55 expenditures.

AB 55 Loans remain open project loans until the state's access to debt markets improves. The Board maintains that there is no issue with the credit worthiness of the borrowing department or agency, nor is there a challenge to the authority to issue project bonds. As such, AB 55 Loans continue to accrue interest that will be paid back to the Pool, along with principal, once the state sells bonds related to the loans.

The State Treasurer's Office continues to explore alternative funding options, such as the recent

private placement of \$194 million with the Bay Area Transportation Authority to fund selected projects, and options available through the federal economic stimulus package (the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act).

## IN-BOX

### *A Synopsis of Current Events in Public Finance*

#### California's Innovative Private Placement

The State Treasurer's Office recently closed an innovative financing deal that privately placed \$194 million with the Bay Area Toll Authority (BATA). The private placement was necessitated to keep funds flowing for eleven road projects in the Bay Area, since state financing for thousands of bond-finance infrastructure projects was suspended during the state budget crisis.<sup>1</sup> While a budget has been passed, it is anticipated that it could take weeks before funds are flowing to projects.

According to the terms of the deal, the state will pay BATA 3.34 percent over 18 months. At maturity, the state will buy back the bonds and resell them to the public market as long-term obligations. The Treasurer's Office is contemplating future private placements with foundations or other investors interested in funding stem cell research, environmental protection as well as other projects. California has not issued General Obligation bonds since June 2008 due to a combination of the uncertainty in the public markets and the state's budget crisis and last issued Revenue Anticipation Notes (RANS) in October 2008.

#### LAO Report: Fiscal Year 2009-10 Budget Outlook

The Legislative Analyst's Office (LAO) released another report in its 2009-10 Budget Analysis Series. The latest report, *The Fiscal Outlook Under the February Budget Package*, highlights the major components of the recently approved fiscal year 2009-10 budget, includes the LAO's long-term economic forecast, and outlines recommendations for the Legislature to consider for the May revise budget planning.<sup>2</sup>

In the report, the LAO's finds that due to the state's deteriorating economy that there may be an \$8 billion deficit for fiscal year 2009-10 budget. Declining revenues contribute to the immediate deficit but the temporary solution of some of the budget solutions enacted in the 2009-10 budget also contribute to budget deficits in the future: \$12.6 billion in 2010-11 and \$26 billion in 2013-14. To address the identified deficits, the LAO recommends that the state maximize available federal economic stimulus funds and continue to develop programmatic solutions.

#### Regulatory Framework for Credit Ratings

Standard & Poor's (S&P) recently issued a white paper, *Toward a Global Regulatory Framework for Credit Ratings*, that focuses on

what can be done to increase transparency and preserve the analytical independence of rating agency opinions and processes. Well crafted regulation, S&P believes, can enhance the ratings process and restore investor confidence.

In the paper, S&P offers recommendations for regulation of credit agencies. Generally, the goals for regulation should instill in investors that ratings are independent, credible, transparent, consist and comparable across asset classes and geography. Ideally, rating definitions should be clear and the use of the ratings consistent with these definitions. In addition, ratings should differentiate new and different securities for investors.

According to S&P, since credit rating agencies conduct business around the world, a regulatory framework that provides consistent standards across jurisdictions can promote soundness for credit ratings internationally as well as domestically. The paper also highlighted the components that S&P's suggested for an international regulatory framework, which includes performance measures, disclosure of rating methodologies and the development of a code of ethics.

#### Market Activity for February

The increased municipal market activity in January 2009 did not continue into February. There were 678 issues with a par value of \$20.3 billion sold in February, down almost five percent (-4.9%) from 2008, when 778 issues with a total par value of \$21.4 were sold. Last February the auction rate securities market began to unravel and the subsequent refunding of those obligations still contributes to current market activity.

While February activity was down, according to Thomson Reuters data, overall municipal market activity for the first two months of 2009 is still up approximately five percent over last year (\$43.6 billion in 2009 to \$41.6 billion in 2008). Based on bond sale volume, California issuers sold \$2.4 billion in bonds in February. The largest issue nationwide in February was the \$950 million General Obligation offering by the Los Angeles Unified School District. ### SELECTED REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

Under existing law (California Government Code Section 8855(k)), "The issuer of any proposed new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation incorporated for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 30 days prior to the sale of any debt issue at public or private sale, give written notice of the proposed sale to the Commission, by mail, postage prepaid."

Under California Government Code Section 8855(l), "The issuer of any new debt issue of State or local government (or public benefit corporation for the purpose of acquiring student loans) shall, not later than 45 days after the signing of the bond purchase contract in a negotiated or private financing, or after the acceptance of a bid in a competitive offering, submit a report of final sale to the commission by mail, postage prepaid, or by any other method approved by the commission. A copy of the official statement for the issue shall accompany the report of final sale. The Commission may require information to be submitted in the report of final sale that is considered appropriate."

Under California Government Code Section 53583(c)(2)(B) if a "local agency determines to sell the (refunding) bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis, the local agency shall send a written statement, within two weeks after the bonds are sold, to the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission explaining the reasons why the local agency determined to sell the bonds at private sale or on a negotiated sale basis instead of at public sale."
