The California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) provides information, education, and technical assistance on debt issuance and public fund investments to local public agencies and other public finance professionals. CDIAC was created to serve as the state's clearinghouse for public debt issuance information and to assist state and local agencies with the monitoring, issuance, and management of public debt.

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INTRODUCTION

Constitutional and statutory provisions require voters to authorize general obligation (GO) bonds issued by state and local governments. For bonds issued by the state, the authorization must be made through a statewide election. Local bonds must be approved by voters within the jurisdiction authorizing the bond. The state and local governments must also seek voter approval for levies of certain revenue exactions and taxes. For both state and local measures, the voter approval threshold depends on the type and purpose of the bond or tax (see Figure 1).

After each statewide election, the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) publishes a statistical summary and review of bond and tax measures appearing on state and local ballots. This report, the 35th in the series, summarizes the results of bond and tax measures on the ballots of 2019 local elections. This report also contains appendices which summarize the measures by county, region, type of tax and purpose.

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2019 LOCAL ELECTION RESULTS

SUMMARY

- *Total measures* – Voters considered 52 local fiscal measures: fifty-one tax measures, and one affordable housing general obligation (GO) bond measure.
- *Approved measures* – Voters approved 44 (84.6 percent) of the measures.
- *Passage rates* – Excluding the sole GO bond measure that was approved by voters, local general tax measures received the greatest support from voters with a 90 percent approval rate. (Figure 2)

GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND MEASURE

- *Background* – Voters in San Francisco City and County were presented with an affordable housing GO bond measure. The \$600 million GO bond will fund rental housing for extremely low- and low-income individuals and families; repair and rebuild public housing developments; acquire and construct housing for seniors; and support

affordable housing for employees in the education field.

- *Strong support* – Unlike most education GO bonds which require 55 percent voter approval, this affordable housing GO bond required two-thirds voter approval. Voters demonstrated their strong support of this measure by approving the GO bond by 71.2 percent.

TAX MEASURES

- *Support for tax measures* – Voters approved 84.3 percent of local general and special tax measures. (Figure 3)
- *Support for local general tax measures* – Local general tax measures were strongly supported (95.0 percent passage rate).
- *Majority vs. two-thirds voting requirement* – All the general tax measures needed only a majority of the vote to pass. If these measures had a two-thirds voting requirement, only 60 percent (12 of the 20 local general tax measures requiring majority voter approval) would have passed. In contrast, the special tax measures (31),

required two-thirds voter approval to pass; these measures had a 77.4 percent passage rate. If these measures required a majority vote, 93.5 percent of the measures (29 of the 31 special tax measures) would have passed.

- *Purpose of taxes* – Most of the measures were special taxes for purposes such as capital improvements, public health and safety, education, and parks and recreation. The general tax measures were for various general government purposes. (Figure 4)

*Miscellaneous purposes include parks, recreational facilities and affordable housing.

RESULTS BY REGION

The election results are divided into five regions: Bay Area, Central Valley, Los Angeles, San Diego/Inland Empire, and Other. (Figure 5)

- *Approved Measures* – Bay Area region voters were presented with the most measures (21). Voters in the San Diego/Inland Empire region were presented with the least measures (one).

- *Passage Rates* – The Bay Area region had the highest passage for GO bond and tax measures (90.5 percent). Other than the San Diego/Inland Empire region which had one measure (failed) on the ballot, the "Other" region had the lowest passage rate (71.4 percent).

Figure 6 shows the number and percentage of measures that were approved by region.

COMPARISON OF THE 2017 AND 2019 LOCAL ELECTIONS

- *Comparative passage rates* – The passage rate of bond and tax measures during the 2019 local elections was 84.6 percent, whereas the 2017 local elections passage rate was 62.5 percent.
- *Comparative number of approved measures* – The number of approved measures in 2019 was 44 (out of 52) and the number of approved measures in 2017 was 60 (out of 96).
- *General government measure passage rates* – General government measures had a lower passage rate in 2017 (90.6 percent) than 2019 (95.0 percent).
- *Special tax measure passage rates* – The passage rate for special tax measures was lower in 2017 (50.9 percent) than 2019 (77.4 percent).
- *Regional passage rates* – In the 2017 local elections, the San Diego/Inland Empire region had the highest passage rate (77.8 percent), but the Bay Area region had the highest passage rate (90.5 percent) in 2019.
- *Passage rates by purpose* – In 2017 the passage rate for general government was the highest (90.6 percent) and in 2019, the passage rate for capital improvements (100.0 percent) was the highest.
- *Comparative number of proposed local measures* – The highest number of proposed local measures in 2017 and 2019 was special tax measures (57 and 31 measures, respectively). In 2017 and 2019, GO bond measures comprised the fewest number of measures. (Figure 8)

* In 2017, miscellaneous includes various purposes such as public library services, parks and recreation, police services/road maintenance/drainage, law and code enforcement maintenance, and public safety/fire/health/housing/roads/environmental protection. In 2019, this category includes affordable housing, parks and recreation.

SUMMARY

Voters were more supportive of the local bond and tax measures in the 2019 local elections (84.6 percent) than the 2017 local elections (62.5 percent). In both elections, general government and public health and safety measures comprised the majority of the ballot measures: 61.5 percent in 2017 and 69.2 percent in 2019. Also, in the 2017 and 2019 local elections, voters greatly supported general tax measures (90.6 percent and 90 percent, respectively). Interestingly, none of the education-related measures on the 2019 local election ballots were GO bonds; instead, they were all parcel tax measures. Whereas, in the 2017 local elections, education-related measures were distributed between GO bond measures (85.7 percent) and parcel tax measures (25.5 percent).
