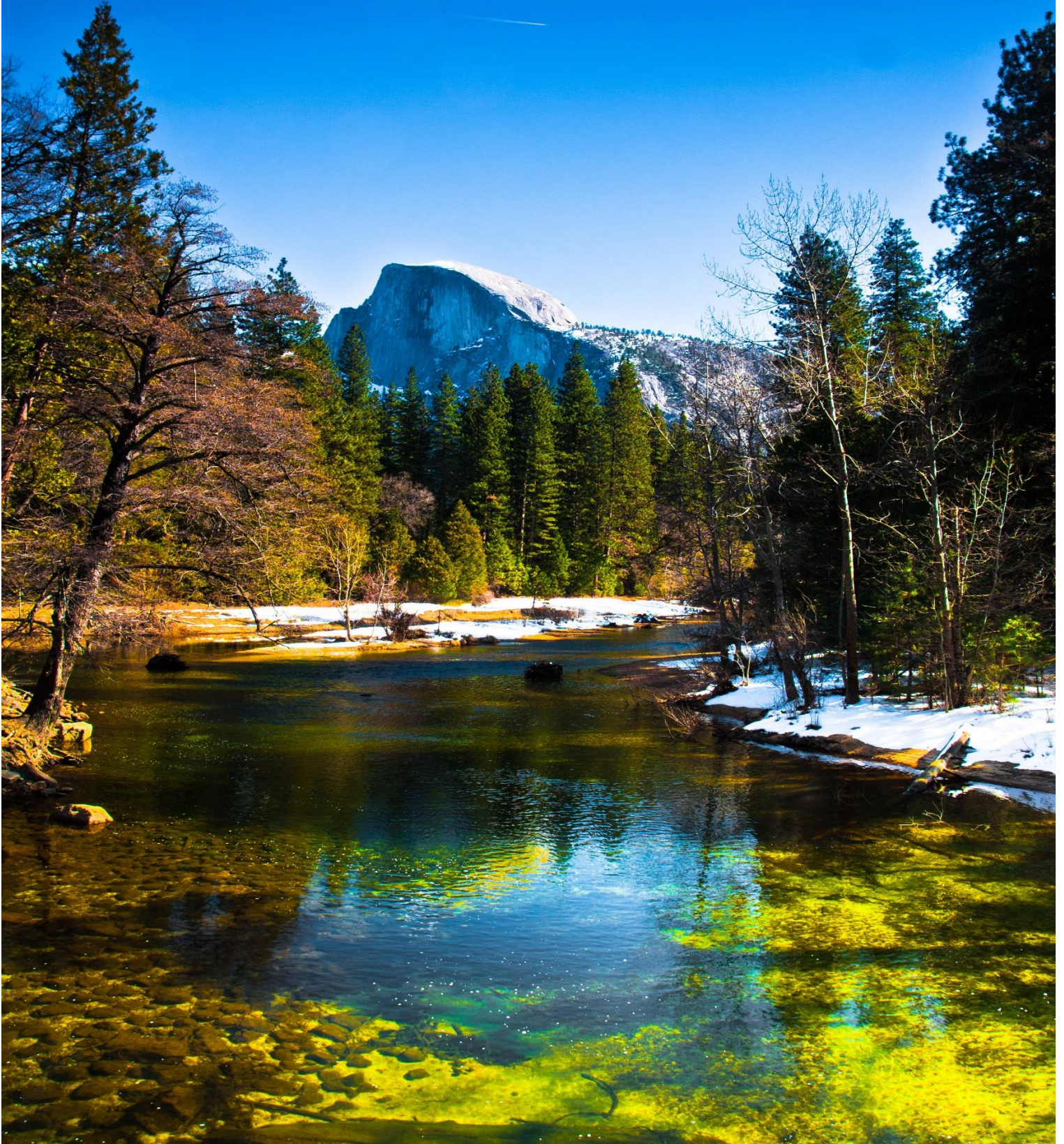

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INTRODUCTION

Constitutional and statutory provisions require voters to authorize general obligation (GO) bonds issued by state and local governments. For bonds issued by the state, the authorization must be made through a statewide election. Local bonds must be approved by voters within the jurisdiction authorizing the bond. The state and local governments must also seek voter approval for levies of certain revenue exactions and taxes. For both state and local measures, the voter approval threshold depends on the type and purpose of the bond or tax (see Figure 1).

After each statewide election, the California Debt and Investment Advisory Commission (CDIAC) publishes a statistical summary and review of bond and tax measures appearing on state and local ballots. This report, the 36th in the series, summarizes the results of bond and tax measures on the March 3, 2020 Presidential Primary Election ballot as well as a local election that occurred on April 14, 2020. This report also contains appendices which summarize the

measures by county, region, type of tax and purpose.

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2020 PRIMARY AND LOCAL ELECTION RESULTS

SUMMARY

- *Total measures* – Voters considered one statewide and 242 local fiscal measures: 115 tax measures and 128 general obligation bond measures.
- *Approved measures* – Voters approved 94 (38.68%) of the measures: all 94 were local measures with no statewide measure approved.
- *Passage rates* – Primary general tax measures received the greatest support from voters with a 59.5% approval rate. (Figure 2)

GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND MEASURES

- *Lack of support for GO bond measures* – Voters approved only 34.4% of these measures. (Figure 3)
- *Volume of approved measures* – Voters approved approximately \$7.2 billion in GO bond measures.
- *K-12 educational focus* – The purpose of 90.6% of GO bond measures was K-12 education. (Figure 4)
- *Lack of support for K-12 educational GO bonds* – Voters approved 35.3% (approximately \$4.8 billion) of K-12 education GO bond measures.
- *Weak support for community college GO bonds* – Voters approved 25% (approximately \$1.7 billion) of community college GO bond measures.

TAX MEASURES

- *Lack of support for tax measures* – Voters approved 43.5% of state and local (general and special) tax measures. (Figure 5)
- *Modest support for primary general tax measures* – Primary general tax measures had a passage rate of 59.5%.
- *Majority vs. two-thirds voting requirement* – General tax measures only need a majority of the vote to pass. If these measures had a two-thirds voting requirement, only 14.29% (6 of the 42 local primary tax measures requiring majority voter approval) would have passed. In contrast, the special tax measures (71), required two-thirds voter approval. These measures were weakly supported with only a 33.8% passage rate. If these measures required a majority vote, 76% of the measures (54 of the 71 special tax measures) would have passed.
- *Purpose of taxes* – Most of the tax measures were general taxes for various general government purposes. The remaining measures were for education, public health and safety, and capital improvements. (Figure 6)

RESULTS BY REGION

The election results are divided into five regions: Bay Area, Central Valley, Los Angeles, San Diego/Inland Empire, and Other. (Figure 7)

- *Approved Measures* – Bay Area region voters were presented with the most measures (62) with Central Valley following closely behind (59). Voters in multiple regions were presented with the least measures (five).

- *Passage Rates* – The Bay Area region had the highest passage rate for GO bond and tax measures (59.7%). Measures in multiple regions had the lowest passage rate (0.0%) with San Diego/Inland Empire having the second lowest passage rate (16.7%).

COMPARISON OF THE 2018 AND 2020 PRIMARY ELECTIONS

- *Comparative passage rates* – The passage rate of bond and tax measures during the 2020 Primary Election was significantly lower (38.6%), than the 2018 Primary Election (79.0%). (Figure 9)
- *Comparative number of approved measures* – While the number of approved measures in 2020, 93 (out of 241) was higher than the amount approved in 2018, 83 (out of 105), there more measures on the ballot in 2020 which resulted in a lower overall voter approval rate. (Figure 10)
- *General government measure passage rates* – General government measures had a lower passage rate in 2020 (59.1%) than 2018 (87%). (Figure 12)
- *Special tax measure passage rates* – The passage rate for special tax measures was lower in 2020 (33.8%) than 2018 (68.4%). (Figure 10)
- *Regional passage rates* – Excluding the "Multiple" region category, in the 2018 Primary Election, the San Diego/Inland Empire and Los Angeles regions had the highest passage rate at 100% and 86.7% respectively. In contrast , the Bay Area region had the highest passage rate at 59.7% in 2020. (Figure 11)
- *Passage rates by purpose* – In 2018 the passage rate for capital improvements was the highest at 100% and the passage rate for general government at 59.1% was the highest in the 2020 Primary Election. (Figure 12)
- *Comparative number of proposed local measures* – In both Primary Elections, the highest percentage of proposed local measures was for educational use, 47.6% in 2018 and 62.7% in 2020. (Figure 12)

*In 2018, this category includes various purposes such as STEM job opportunities programs, amendment of property tax rules, mental health services, cemetery maintenance, clubhouse renovations, district facilities maintenance, early childhood education, drug prevention, literacy programs, housing programs, park and recreation facilities, library, youth programs, parks and open space, and beaches. In 2020, this category includes park and recreation facilities, small business programs, housing programs, and arts and culture programs and facilities.

SUMMARY

For the first time since 1994, California voters rejected a statewide education-related bond measure (Proposition 13). While voters widely supported bond and tax measures in the 2018 Primary Election with a 78.6% approval rate, these measures did not fare well in the 2020 Primary Election which had a 38.6% approval rate. In both elections, education and general government measures comprised the majority of the ballot measures: 69.9% in 2018 and 80.9 percent in 2020. However, when comparing passage rates for education measures, there was a high rate of passage in 2018 (85.7%), while 2020 saw a significant decline in support (37.1%). Additionally, all other purpose categories (general government, capital improvements, public health and safety, and miscellaneous) experienced significant declines in support in the 2020 Primary Election. Of the five cannabis measures presented to voters in the 2020 Primary Election, only one passed.
