Friday, March 4	<b>Final recommendations posted.</b>
Tuesday, March 8	Appeals to final recommendations due.
<b>Wednesday, March 16</b>	<b>Allocation Meeting.</b>
Tuesday, June 14 Friday, June 24 Tuesday, July 5 Thursday, July 14  Monday, July 25	90-day expiration date. 100-day expiration date (if lottery held). 110-day expiration date (if lottery held). 120-day expiration date for MCC & SL awards only. 130-day expiration date for Rental Projects that have not received tax credits only.
