**Background:** Established in 1960, JWCH is a licensed, non-profit health agency dedicated to the underserved population of Los Angeles County through the direct provision and/or coordination of health care, health education services and research. JWCH's services include: primary care for adults, family planning, male wellness services, EKGs, HIV testing, laboratory services, pharmaceuticals, health education, and referrals for specialty services.

**Uses of Loan Proceeds:** Loan proceeds will be used to purchase real estate located in the city of Lynwood to be used as the situs for JWCH's new community clinic.

#### **Financing Structure**

- 15-year fixed rate loan.
- 180 equal monthly payments of approximately \$5,179 (yearly payments of about \$62,148).
- First (1<sup>st</sup>) lien position on the property located at: 3591 E. Imperial Highway, Lynwood, CA 90262
- Loan to value ratio not to exceed 95% (estimated loan to value ratio of 88%).
- Gross revenue pledge.

**Financial Overview:** JWCH's income statement appears to exhibit positive operating results with increasing net income over the past three fiscal years, combined with continued revenue growth from newly developed programs. JWCH's balance sheet appears strong with good liquidity, a solid current ratio, and significant net assets, plus no long-term debt. In addition, proforma debt service coverage is a solid 6.04x.

### **Financial Discussion:**

JWCH's income statement exhibits positive operating results with increasing net income over the past three fiscal years, along with continued revenue growth from newly developed programs.

JWCH has posted increases in unrestricted net assets for all three years of our review period, an annual improvement.

### **Important Facts to Note:**

- JWCH experienced an impressive 39% increase in total revenue from FY 06 to FY 08. The increase relates to various new/increased grants, including: an HIV/AIDS Substance Abuse Services contract through SAMHSA and a Recuperative Care Services contract through Los Angeles County, DHS, and DMH. JWCH expects visits and revenue to continue increasing primarily due to anticipated population growth in JWCH's service area and their continued focus on opening additional health centers.
- In FY 08, grants comprised 57% of JWCH's total revenue. The majority of JWCH's grants are federal and local grants for indigent care. JWCH has received long-term commitments from these grantors and does not expect to experience a drastic decline in such funds in the near future.

JWCH's balance sheet appears strong with good liquidity, a solid current ratio, and significant net assets, plus no long-term debt. In addition, proforma debt service coverage is a solid 6.04x.

JWCH's current balance sheet appears solid. For FY 08, JWCH had good liquidity, as indicated by a balance of over \$700,000 in cash and a solid current ratio of 1.74%. JWCH's proforma long-term debt to unrestricted net assets is low at 0.35x, indicating low leverage. JWCH has no long-term debt and currently possesses a solid proforma debt service coverage ratio of 6.04x. JWCH should be able to comfortably repay the proposed HELP II loan.

#### IV. ORGANIZATION

### **Background and Licensing**

JWCH Institute, Inc. is a private, non-profit health agency established in 1960 by concerned Los Angeles County physicians. These staff physicians sought to establish an agency that could obtain additional funds to support and augment patient care, education, and research at the John Wesley facility. When the hospital was demolished in 1979, the agency continued its efforts to assist Los Angeles County patients, but the name was no longer relevant and was subsequently changed to JWCH Institute, Inc.

JWCH's mission is to improve the health status and well-being of underserved segments of the population of Los Angeles County through the direct provision or coordination of health care, health education services and research.

This mission is being accomplished through a variety a variety of programs and activities, such as: medical outreach and referrals for medical care, HIV services and drug treatment; health education; psychosocial assessment and intervention; primary medical care; family planning services; and research.

JWCH operates a variety of health care facilities throughout Los Angeles county, including: the JWCH Medical Clinic at the Weingart Center, the Bell Gardens Health Center, the Norwalk Health Center, the Women's Clinic-Lynwood, the Safe Harbor Women's Clinic, the JWCH Clinic at PATH, and the Covenant House-Hollywood. JWCH also manages and operates programs for the homeless, youth, those affected by HIV/AIDS, as well as programs promoting women's health.

JWCH is licensed by the California Department of Public Health for its community clinic.
