

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that on Wednesday, August 24, 2011, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code") will be held with respect to the proposed issuance by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority of the California Health Facilities Financing Authority Variable Rate Revenue Bonds (Casa Colina), Series 2011 (the "Bonds"), in an amount not to exceed \$50,000,000 for the benefit of Casa Colina, Inc., Casa Colina Hospital for Rehabilitative Medicine, Casa Colina Centers for Rehabilitation Foundation, Casa Colina Centers for Rehabilitation, Inc., Casa Colina Comprehensive Outpatient Rehabilitation Services, Inc. and Padua Village, Inc., each a nonprofit public benefit corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of California and described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. The proceeds of the Bonds will be used by Casa Colina, Inc., Casa Colina Hospital for Rehabilitative Medicine, Casa Colina Centers for Rehabilitation Foundation, Casa Colina Centers for Rehabilitation, Inc., Casa Colina Comprehensive Outpatient Rehabilitation Services, Inc. and/or Padua Village, Inc.: (1) to finance or refinance the construction, renovation, expansion and equipping of certain portions of the health care and related facilities, owned and/or operated by one or more of the above-identified corporations, located or to be located in Pomona, California on the Casa Colina campus, which is bounded by North Garey Avenue and Bonita Avenue; (2) to fund interest during construction; and (3) to pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds.

The hearing will commence at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held in Suite 590, 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California. Interested persons wishing to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds or on the nature and location of the facilities proposed to be financed or refinanced may attend the public hearing or, prior to the time of the hearing, submit written comments to Barbara J. Liebert, Executive Director, California Health Facilities Financing Authority, 915 Capitol Mall, Suite 590, Sacramento, California 95814.
