

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on February 25, 2015, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code") will be held with respect to the proposed issuance by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority of its revenue bonds in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$80,000,000 (the "Bonds"). The proceeds of the Bonds will be used to (1) finance and refinance the acquisition, construction, improvement, equipping and renovation of certain health facilities located at the following addresses: The Sequoias - Portola Valley, 501 Portola Road, Portola Valley, California 94028; The Sequoias - San Francisco, 1400 Geary Boulevard, 1501 Post Street, and 1500 Laguna Avenue, San Francisco, California 94109; The Tamalpais, 501 Via Casitas, Greenbrae, California 94904; and The Woods, 43300 Little River Airport Road, Little River, California 95456 and (2) to pay certain expenses incurred in connection with the issuance of the Bonds. The above health facilities are owned and/or operated, or to be owned and/or operated, by Northern California Presbyterian Homes and Services, Inc., a California nonprofit public benefit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

The hearing will commence at 10:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held at 915 Capitol Mall, Suite 590, Sacramento, California. Interested persons wishing to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds or on the nature and location of the health facilities proposed to be financed or refinanced may attend the public hearing in person or by phone (877) 807-5706 (participation code 972536) or TDD (916) 654-9922 or, prior to the time of the hearing, submit written comments to Barbara J. Liebert, Executive Director, California Health Facilities Financing Authority, 915 Capitol Mall, Suite 590, Sacramento, CA 95814. The Authority may limit the time available for persons attending the public hearing to provide comments while assuring such persons a reasonable opportunity to be heard.
