

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
CHFFA/SUTTER HEALTH**

Notice is hereby given that on September 23, 2015, a public hearing as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code (the "Code") will be held by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority (the "Authority") with respect to the proposed issuance by the Authority of its revenue bonds in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$230,000,000 (the "Bonds"). The proceeds of the Bonds will be used by Sutter Health (the "Corporation") or certain of its affiliates to refinance costs of acquisition, construction, expansion, remodeling, renovation, furnishing and equipping of the following health facilities: the health facilities operated by Mills-Peninsula Health Services and located generally at 2900 Chanticleer Avenue, Santa Cruz; the health facilities operated by Sutter Health Sacramento Sierra Region and located generally at One Medical Plaza, Roseville; the health facilities operated by Palo Alto Medical Foundation for Health Care, Research and Education and located generally at 3200 Kearney Street, Fremont; 701 El Camino Real, Mountain View; and 795 El Camino Real, Palo Alto; and the health facilities operated by Sutter Gould Medical Foundation and located generally at 600 Coffee Road, Modesto; and 1409 E. Briggsmore Avenue, Modesto. Each of the facilities listed above are owned by the Corporation or one of its affiliates, and operated by the Corporation or one of its affiliates, each a California nonprofit public benefit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

The hearing will commence at 10:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, and will be held in Suite 590, 915 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California. Interested persons wishing to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds or on the nature and location of the health facilities proposed to be financed or refinanced may attend the public hearing in person or by phone (888) 240-3210 (participation code 6698139) or TDD (916) 654-9922 or, prior to the time of the hearing, submit written comments to Diane Stanton, Executive Director, California Health Facilities Financing Authority, 915 Capitol Mall, Suite 590, Sacramento, California 95814. The Authority may limit the time available for persons attending the public hearing to provide comments while assuring such persons a reasonable opportunity to be heard.
