NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, on Wednesday, August 3, 2016 (previously scheduled for July 27, 2016), a public hearing will be held as required by section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code") with respect to the proposed issuance by the California Health Facilities Financing Authority of revenue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$6,500,000 (the "Bonds") relating to the financing and refinancing of projects for Petaluma Health Center, Inc., a California nonprofit, public benefit corporation (the "Corporation").
