The proceeds of the Bonds will be used by Memorial Health Services, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation (the "Borrower"), or certain of its affiliates (as described herein), to (A) refinance a portion of the cost of acquisition, construction, expansion, remodeling, renovation, furnishing and equipping of three three-story buildings comprising a total of approximately 300,000 square feet, together with adjacent land and a parking structure, constituting the Borrower's headquarters, corporate located at Fountain Valley City Centre, new 17330-17390 Brookhurst Street, Fountain Valley, California, which is owned and operated by the Borrower, (B) refinance the cost of acquisition, construction, furnishing and equipping of land and surface parking at 10101 Slater Avenue, Fountain Valley, California, which is owned and operated by the Borrower, (C) refinance the cost of acquisition, construction, expansion, remodeling, renovation, furnishing and equipping, including through the construction of a five-level parking structure, of Long Beach Memorial Medical Center, a 458-licensed-bed acute care hospital facility, and Miller Children's & Women's Hospital Long Beach, a 371-licensed-bed acute care hospital facility, each located at 2801 Atlantic Avenue, Long Beach, California, which are owned and operated by Long Beach Memorial Medical Center, and (D) refinance the cost of acquisition of equipment for the following hospital facilities: (i) Orange Coast Memorial Medical Center, a 218-licensed-bed acute care hospital facility located at 18111 Brookhurst Street, Fountain Valley, California, which is owned and operated by Orange Coast Memorial Medical Center, and (ii) Saddleback Memorial Medical Center Laguna Hills, a 252-licensed-bed acute care hospital facility located at 24451 Health Center Drive, Laguna Hills, California, which is owned and operated by Saddleback Memorial Medical Center. The facilities listed above are owned and operated by the Borrower or one of its affiliates, each a California nonprofit public benefit corporation and an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.
