A. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT NO. 18MSC004 WITH THE CALIFORNIA AIR RESOURCES BOARD REGARDING THE CALIFORNIA CAPITAL ACCESS PROGRAM INDEPENDENT CONTRIBUTOR PROGRAM

The proposed Agreement between CPCFA and CARB is a continuation of the CalCAP/CARB Loan Program currently administered under the interagency agreement 13-606. The new agreement will allocate an amount of \$25.6 million of new CARB funds toward the CalCAP/CARB Loan Program, while the term of the Agreement will be from April 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

The Agreement will also make some programmatic changes to the current agreement to provide for the new CARB emission requirements effective January 1, 2020; such as limiting the financing of new and used trucks to 2010 and later model year engines, no longer permitting the financing of exhaust retrofits, allowing the financing of equipment warranty, when funded with the purchase of an eligible truck, and it will also amend the Borrower Eligibility Criteria and Self-Certification Form to help track the loan enrollment of fleets that have received Notices of Non-Compliance from CARB's streamlined enforcement process.

The funds remaining under the current agreement 13-606, approximately \$35 million, which had not been disbursed yet for loan enrollments or administrative costs, will also be transferred for use in the new Agreement, subject to a subsequent amendments.

Staff recommended the approval of Resolution No. 19-02-001 authorizing the execution of the new Interagency Agreement No. 18MSC004 with the California Air Resources Board to continue to participate as an Independent Contributor in CalCAP/CARB Loan Program in the amount of \$25.6 million with a term from April 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020.

Mr. Agee asked if there were any further comments. There were none.

Ms. Finn moved approval of the item; there was a second.
