

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”), that a public hearing will be held before the Deputy Executive Director of the California Pollution Control Financing Authority (the “Authority”) or a designee on Friday, March 12, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., Pacific Time, or as soon thereafter as such matters may be heard, in Room 270, 801 Capitol Mall, 2nd Floor, Sacramento, California 95814, on the proposed issuance by the Authority of one or more series of exempt facility bonds for a sewage facility pursuant to section 142(a)(5) of the Code and/or for a solid waste disposal facility pursuant to section 142(a)(6) of the Code in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$13,000,000 (the “Bonds”).

The proceeds of the Bonds will finance and/or refinance a portion of the costs of the acquisition, construction and/or equipping of a sewage treatment facility and biomethane plant, to be located at 20111 Shay Road, Victorville, California 92394 (the “Project”). Such portion comprising financed assets will be owned and operated by SoCal Biomethane, LLC.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the proposed financing will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether the Bonds should be issued.
