## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that a public hearing will be held before the Executive Director of the California Pollution Control Financing Authority (the "Authority") or a designee on Monday, July 18, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., California time, or as soon thereafter as such matters may be heard, in Room 270 of 801 Capitol Mall, Sacramento, California 95814, on the proposed issuance by the Authority of one or more series of tax-exempt revenue notes in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$6,125,000 (the "Series 2022 Notes"), to finance and refinance qualified solid waste disposal facilities as defined in Section 142(a)(6) of the Code.

On October 3, 2018, the Authority previously issued the California Pollution Control Financing Authority Variable Rate Demand Solid Waste Disposal Revenue Notes (Atlas Disposal Industries, LLC Project) Series 2018 (the "Series 2018 Notes"), in the aggregate principal amount of \$9,470,000 to (1) finance (a) the construction, improvement, and/or installation of a maintenance facility, with related equipment and infrastructure to be located at 8550 Fruitridge Road, Sacramento, CA 95826; (b) the acquisition of compressed natural gas powered waste collection vehicles and/or other equipment used for the collection, transportation, processing or disposal of solid waste throughout Sacramento County, California, and to be housed at 3000 Power Inn Road, Sacramento, CA 95826 or 8550 Fruitridge Road, Sacramento, CA 95826; and (c) the acquisition of containers for the handling and disposal of solid waste to be located at the sites of the Company's customers throughout Sacramento County, California, and (2) refund a prior series of the Authority's revenue bonds issued on behalf of the Company in 1999, which bonds were issued to finance similar costs as described in the prior clause (1), at 3000 Power Inn Road, Sacramento, CA 95826.

The proceeds of the Series 2022 Notes will be used to (i) refund in full the outstanding Series 2018 Notes, and (ii) finance costs and expenses related to the acquisition, construction, installation and/or equipping of compressed natural gas powered waste collection vehicles, an electric vehicle charging station, a building used for storage and maintenance of waste collection containers and vehicles, and/or other equipment used for the collection, transportation, processing or disposal of solid waste throughout Sacramento County, California, and to be housed or located at 8545 Unsworth Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95828, 8547 Unsworth Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95828 and/or 8565 Unsworth Avenue, Sacramento, CA 95828. All financed assets will be owned and operated by Atlas Disposal Industries, LLC, a Utah limited liability company (the "Company") and/or an affiliate thereof.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the proposed financing will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether the Series 2022 Notes should be issued.
