Subject: Approving The Amendment To Resolution 13-35, Which Authorized The Issuance In An Amount Not To Exceed \$25,000,000 In School Facility Revenue Bonds to 2023 Union LLC (Borrower) For The Benefit Of The Parties Listed On Attachment A

At its July 17, 2013 Board meeting, the California School Finance Authority approved Resolution 13-35, which authorized the issuance in an amount not to exceed \$25,000,000 in School Facility Revenue Bonds to 2023 Union LLC (Borrower) for the benefit of 17 Alliance projects/campuses. Since the approval of Resolution 13-35, Alliance College-Ready Middle Academy #12 has been included as a beneficiary of bond proceeds as shown in item 18 of Attachment A. There is no other substantive or structural change to this financing.

Staff recommends that the Board adopt the amendment to Resolution No. 13-35 approving the addition of Alliance College-Ready Middle Academy #12 as a beneficiary of bond proceeds as listed in Attachment A and to direct staff to continue working with the applicant and their financing team to finalize the structure of the transaction for issuance.
