SACRAMENTO -- "I commend Dick's Sporting Goods' decision to no longer sell militarystyle assault weapons and high-capacity magazines. In the wake of Parkland, Sandy Hook, and Columbine, it's about time idle thoughts and prayers are replaced by courageous action and common sense.

"But while Dick's Sporting Goods has grown sick of selling the preferred killing tools of mass murderers, too many other retailers are overly-consumed with shameless profiteering to see a rising body count.
