Resolution to Approve Issuance of Request for Proposals for Program Management Services for ScholarShare 529

Recommendation

ScholarShare Investment Board (SIB or Board) staff recommends that the Board adopt Resolution No. 2020-07, approving the issuance of a request for proposals (RFP) for program management services for ScholarShare 529 (Plan)

Background

In 2011, following a competitive RFP process, TIAA-CREF Tuition Financing, Inc. (TFI) was selected to provide program management services for the Plan. The existing program management contract, Agreement No. SIB 15-10 (Contract), with TFI provides for an initial five-year term, with options for five (5) one-year extensions. In March 2020, the Board approved the final extension option outlined in the Contract to extend the term for one year. The Contract is set to expire on November 6, 2021.

In anticipation of the expiration of the Contract, SIB staff and the Board's consultants are in the process of developing a competitive RFP for these services. In this item, SIB staff has provided a brief overview of the anticipated components of the RFP including a tentative timeline. With Board approval, a competitive RFP for program management services will be issued in early-2021.

WHEREAS, the Board, pursuant to Education Code Section 69981(c)(10), may authorize the Executive Director to enter into contracts on behalf of the Board or conduct any business necessary for the efficient operations of the Board;

WHEREAS, a program manager is needed to provide management services for ScholarShare 529, California's 529 college savings plan, (the "Plan"), which includes maintaining and managing investments, performing administration and customer service, and providing marketing; and

WHEREAS, the term of the Board's existing contract, Agreement No. SIB 15-10 (the "Agreement"), with TIAA-CREF Tuition Financing, Inc. ("TFI") for program management services for the Plan expires on November 6, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Director is hereby authorized to issue a request for proposals for program management services for ScholarShare 529.
