Update on the California Kids Investment and Development Savings Program

Background

In July 2019, the California Kids Investment and Development Savings Program (CalKIDS or Program), California's statewide children's savings account (CSA) program, was established through the signing of Senate Bill 77. Since then, ScholarShare Investment Board (SIB or Board) staff have made progress on the implementation of the Program and provided the Board with periodic updates on various aspects of CalKIDS' development, including subsequent legislative proposals signed into law amending the Program's statute. As CalKIDS further approaches its launch, SIB staff is providing the Board with a quarterly update on the most recent developments with the Program's implementation.
